Arrupe Explorers is a program that seeks to connect these children to opportunities and knowledge in the hopes that they have the tools to realize their personal future goals with confidence. This year high school students will continue to act as small group leaders and personal mentors, while building relationships with children. High school mentors will play a special role in supporting the children in goal-setting and decision-making in regards to their future careers and life choices. At <u>minimum</u>, volunteer mentors are required to attend <u>weekly</u> after-school meetings virtually, <u>every</u> Thursday throughout the academic year or semester in which you are a small group leader.
