

Position Profile: Custodial Services Part-Time Floor Technician

About the Position: Saint Ignatius High School, a highly successful Jesuit college preparatory school for boys in Cleveland, Ohio, is seeking an experienced Floor Technician. The Floor Technician reports to the Custodial Services Supervisor and is responsible for all flooring maintenance across campus including vinyl composite tile, ceramic, terazzo and carpet extraction. Floor maintenance will be performed based on a floor work schedule including special projects as needed. The ideal candidate will bring at least 3 years experience with floor work and general cleaning as well as training on safety, equipment use, and floor techniques. This part-time, year round, position works approximately 4.5 hours each day, Monday-Thursday, Friday – 5.0 hrs, subject to change based on events and special projects.

As a Catholic School in the Jesuit tradition, Saint Ignatius has been educating "Men for Others" for 130 years. The school is known locally, as well as nationally, as a leader in educational excellence. At graduation, students will be open to growth, intellectually competent, religious, loving, and committed to peace and justice.

Primary Areas of Responsibility:

- Perform floor maintenance work in all areas of campus as scheduled.
- Coordinate with Custodial Services Supervisor to meet assigned tasks.
- Perform general cleaning including trash removal, dusting, sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, disinfecting, polishing as needed.
- Assist with maintenance projects and event setup and tear down as needed.

Qualifications:

- 3 years of floor work and general cleaning preferred
- Ability to walk, climb, stretch, bend, and lift up to 50 pounds
- High school diploma or GED preferred
- Valid driver's license required

The successful candidate will also demonstrate the following:

- Ability to read, understand, and execute written plans and directions.
- Customer service focused and detail oriented.
- Good interpersonal communication skills.
- Professional attitude, demeanor, and work ethic.
- Ability to work both independently and in a team setting.

Flexibility and willingness to work occasional weekends.
