SATURDAY ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Every student begins his REACHing MAGIS experience with the Saturday Academic Program, which starts in the fall and concludes in the winter. Accelerated and remedial classes are offered and designed to improve each student's skills in Language Arts and Mathematics. The program also incorporates Lego Robotics (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math), Graphic Arts, Web Design, Entrepreneurship with "pitch" experience, and Test Preparation for any standard test.
