- Individual Financial Aid awards are determined using the FACTS Grant & Aid Process. Applications for the Class of 2025 are due in November 2020 with notification in late December 2020.
- Due to COVID-19, Saint Ignatius High School established a Family Tuition Relief Fund. Forty-one families in the Class of 2024 received a total of \$89,150 of additional aid. Families who applied were granted additional aid based on a proven need due to a layoff, furlough or other financial hardship due to the pandemic.
