MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Saint Ignatius High School will be offering Merit Scholarships to all students who demonstrate excellence on our Entrance Exam. Those students who score from 93-96 on the exam will receive \$3,000 **renewable** awards, and those students who score from 97-99 on the test will receive \$6,000 **renewable** awards. A student must meet academic and disciplinary standards to be eligible for renewal.

NEED-BASED TUITION ASSISTANCE

All prospective students who would like to apply for Tuition Assistance for the 2020-2021 school year must complete a FACTS Grant & Aid Application to gather and analyze family financial information to assess a family's ability to pay tuition.

It is the policy of Saint Ignatius High School that both biological parents must file for financial assistance in order for financial aid to be granted to their student.

DEADLINES & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Application and all supporting documents must be completed no later than November 15, 2020 if the prospective student/family wants to ensure that they will receive their financial assistance before having to make their high school decision. - Please note that FACTS no longer accepts faxed or mailed tax documents. All documents must be uploaded to the website above. The application is mobile friendly.
- Families who complete this process will receive an estimated tuition assistance award in writing by early January.
- Only one application needs to be completed for all high schools to which the student is applying.
- Complete, accurate and timely information is required. Applications submitted after the deadline and/or with incomplete or inaccurate information may result in reduction or denial of Tuition Assistance.
- It is important to note that the deadline for prospective students (Class of 2025) is several months earlier than the deadline for returning students. Families with a returning student and a prospective student must complete an application for their prospective student(s) by November 15, 2020, (based on their 2019 tax return) and complete an application for their returning student(s) by May 1, 2021, (based on their 2020 tax return).
- For residents of the City of Cleveland and residents of other select schools, Saint Ignatius accepts the Cleveland Scholarship Voucher and EdChoice Scholarships from the Ohio Department of Education. The renewal forms and application are available in February.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Tuition Assistance

WHAT IS THE COST OF TUITION?

The cost of tuition for the 2020-2021 school year is \$18,000. Each student is charged an annual \$350 Education Fee, which covers the cost of materials used in class. Seniors are also charged a \$165 Graduation Fee. This fee covers the costs incurred for Graduation Mass, Senior Awards Night, and Commencement exercises, and includes a yearbook for each graduating senior.

DOES SAINT IGNATIUS PARTICIPATE IN THE CLEVELAND VOUCHER & EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS?

Saint Ignatius accepts the City of Cleveland Voucher and EdChoice Scholarships from the Ohio Department of Education. You can apply for both tuition assistance from Saint Ignatius High School and scholarships from the Ohio Department of Education.

WHAT TUITION PAYMENT PLANS ARE OFFERED?

At Saint Ignatius High School, we use the FACTS Tuition Management system. This is a web-based system that all parents are required to use to manage financial aid and the payment of tuition and fees to Saint Ignatius High School.

PAYMENT PLANS & PAYMENT METHODS

If you have an existing FACTS account, the payment plan previously selected will remain in effect for the next school year. If you are new to FACTS or would like to change your payment plan, you will be able to choose from the following payment plans:

One time full payment of tuition (due July 15);

Two equal installments (due July 15 and December 15);

10 equal monthly installments (due monthly July 15 through April 15)

There are no billing fees associated with the first two methods. If you choose the monthly option, there is an additional \$50 annual fee that is assessed.

If an electronic payment is not selected, an additional \$100 maintenance fee will be added to your account for invoice billing.

HOW DO LATE FEES WORK?

Late fees apply to all payment plans. A \$25 late fee will be assessed on an account that has become 10 days delinquent.

DO I NEED TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID EVERY SCHOOL YEAR?

Due to the fact that financial aid is based on a family's need, and situations change from year to year, you must re-apply each school year for tuition assistance.
