

Summer School Visual Arts



The summer Visual Arts course is designed for incoming freshmen that intend on pursuing the newly instituted **Fra. Andrea Pozzo, S.J. Program** within the Fine Arts Department.

The Pozzo Program is for the student who desires an advanced level visual arts sequence during his high school career. By fulfilling the Visual Arts pre-requisite over the summer, these select freshmen will be enrolled in an advanced level visual arts course, such as Drawing, Graphic Design, or 3D Art, during the first and/or second semester of the regular school year. Visual Arts is an introductory studio art course in which students experiment with a variety of art media before progressing into medium - specific coursework. It is designed to elevate artistic awareness through the exploration of fundamental practices and techniques within two and three-dimensional art media (drawing, painting, clay, sculpture, mixed media, and graphic design.)

Students engage in a variety of visual experiences that involve a sampling of art production, criticism, and appreciation.
