TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION 2016-2017

Saint Ignatius High School has students from all parts of Greater Cleveland and Cuyahoga County. They arrive at school by car (often as a member of a car pool), by Regional Transit Authority (RTA), or by buses provided by various school districts.

Cleveland students are offered free **RTA tickets** if you live further than 3 miles from school. To be eligible for these free tickets, you must apply by filling-out Form 519. The 519 Form is **included** in this packet for your convenience. Please return it promptly to the Assistant Principals' Office **by Friday, August 26th**. **It must be returned to the office by August 26th. If you do not return the form by August 26th, you may not be eligible for the RTA tickets.**

Several school districts offer reduced price tickets. The districts are: Lakewood, Maple Heights, North Olmsted. Students residing in other communities may purchase student tickets at a discounted rate. Any and all forms necessary for reduced tickets will be available on orientation day. Remind your son to pick up a form for your community in Mr. Ryan Franzinger's office. Complete the form and return it to the Assistant Principal for Student Discipline before **September 16, 2016**.

Three school districts that bus students to and from Saint Ignatius High School are Berea, including Middleburg Heights, Brook Park and Independence.

For the past several years, parents from the Southwest suburbs have organized a bus to transport students from this area to Saint Ignatius High School. The private transportation company takes the students from Staples in Strongsville, on Pearl Rd., directly to Saint Ignatius in the mornings. Cost is more economical than if you drive yourself.
