

Please note that the dress code requires students to wear *dark colored dress shoes*. Below are examples of acceptable & unacceptable footwear:

Acceptable: Any shoe labeled as a “dress shoe” in brown or black, as evidenced below.



Unacceptable: Any shoe labeled as “casual” or “athletic”, especially those with white bottoms or contrasting markings, as evidenced below:



For your information ~ Sales Tax Holiday

S.B. 264 enacted a sales tax holiday to occur only in 2016. The holiday starts on Friday, August 5, 2016 at 12:00 a.m. and ends on Sunday, August 7, 2016 at 11:59 p.m.

During the holiday, the following items are exempt from sales and use tax:

- Clothing priced at \$75 per item or less;
- School supplies priced at \$20 per item or less; and
- School instructional material priced at \$20 per item or less.

Items used in a trade or business are not exempt under the sales tax holiday.
